## **Sample collection for Ecto ID**

*You will need:*

- Ecto ID form
- Disposable gloves
- Screw top plastic sample tube or similar
- Padded envelope

*Please wear disposable gloves when you collect the sample.*

1. Fill in the Ecto ID form.
2. Gather a suitable sample from your animal (tick, fly, louse, skin scrape or hair plucks). If you're not sure how to collect the sample please call us – we'll be happy to help.
3. Put the sample into the screw-top plastic sample tube (or similar)
4. Place the sealed sample along with the completed form and cheque into the padded envelope, seal and post 1<sup>st</sup> class on the same day\* to:
