### Sample collection for WECs

*You will need:*

- Worm Egg Count form
- Disposable gloves
- Large open top mixing bag (approx. 5" x 7")
- 2 x polythene small grip-seal (or equivalent) bags (approx. 2.5" x 4")
- Padded envelope

*Please wear disposable gloves when you collect the sample.*

1. Fill in the Worm Egg Count form.
2. Gather fresh faeces from **10 different animals**. Make sure each sample is approximately equivalent to 1 heaped teaspoon.
3. Place the samples in the large open top mixing bag.
4. Mix the samples together well so that you get a good representation from your flock/herd.
5. Take a sub-sample of the well mixed faeces from the bag and half fill the small grip-seal (or equivalent) bag and seal securely, removing excess air.
6. Place this sample bag inside the other small grip-seal (or equivalent) bag and seal securely so that the sample is double wrapped and 'postman friendly'.
7. Place the sealed sample along with the completed Worm Egg Count form and cheque into the padded envelope, seal and post 1<sup>st</sup> class on the same day\* to:
